Testing time is upon us, and I know the students are not the only ones being tested during this time. I told Dr. Marshall the other day that Spring Break is definitely a gift that everyone should enjoy- for I feel we all need it.

Some timelines that need to be completed before the end of school:

April 11: ESY (summer school) data and forms should be completed. You do not have to have your IEP's amended by that time; but the forms need to be filled out. Please send Rob or I a note and we will come by and look at your forms to ensure you have the data necessary for proof that ESY is necessary.

April 13: All Alternate Assessments have to be completed and scores entered. Remember if you need a scorer or someone to enter scores onto the website Rob or myself are available.

April 18: Please send me a note if you or your paras are interested in working summer school this year and the dates and times you are available. Also if you are a Middle School or High School teacher please send me the dates and times of your drivers' education classes.

April 2: Para evaluations are due into the office. Remember if you do not want a para to return please do not send us a glowing evaluation. In fact, if you have a para that you do not believe should return please let Rob or myself know so that we can sit in with you when you go over your evaluation.

A heads up- The educational strategies known as RtI (Response to Intervention) or MTSS (Multi-Tier System of Support) cannot be used by schools to delay or deny an evaluation for children suspected of having a disability, say federal education officials. This does not eliminate the 18 -week intervention if the team does not know the needs of the student; however, if a student is obviously blind, deaf, or has an obvious significant disability then testing needs to take place immediately.
